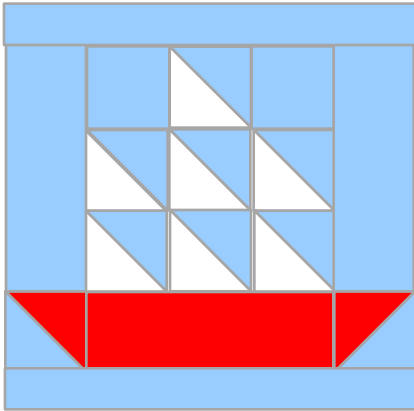


Sailboat

10" finished Block



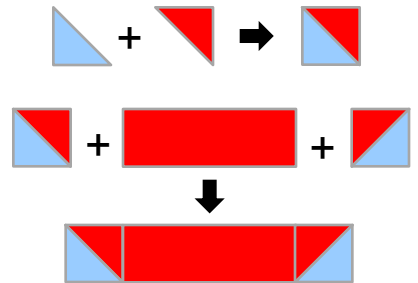
Cutting Instructions

● Red	1	2-½ x 6-½" rectangle
○ Blue	1	2-7/8" square cut on diagonal
○ Blue	2	1-½ x 10-½" rectangles
○ Blue	2	2-½ x 6-½" rectangles
○ White	5	2-7/8" squares cut on diagonal
○ White	2	2-½" squares
○ White	4	2-7/8" squares cut on diagonal

Sewing instructions:

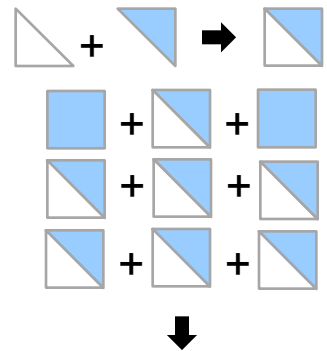
1. Make the boat

- Right sides together, stitch two red and two blue triangles together to form the bow and stern.
- Stitch the bow and stern sections to the body of the boat as shown in the diagram



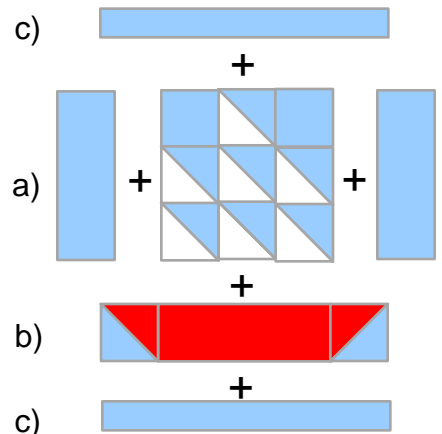
2. Make the sails:

- Discard one blue and one white triangle.
- Right sides together, stitch the remaining blue and white triangles together to form the sail units.
- Following the diagram, make the sail section. This is a nine-patch within the larger block.

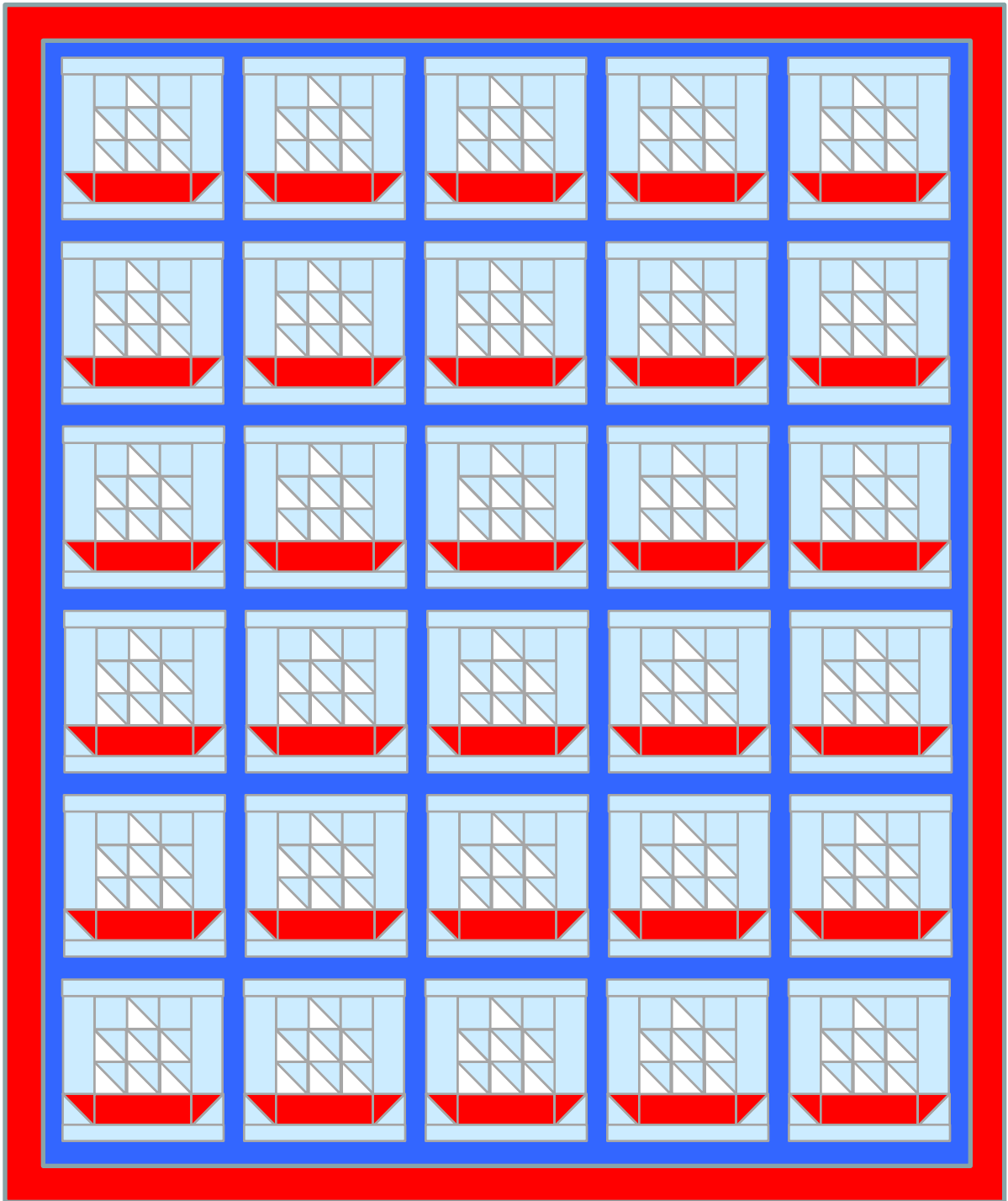


3. Complete the sailboat in this order:

- Right sides together, stitch the blue 6-½" rectangles to each side of the sail (a).
- Right sides together, stitch the boat to the sail (b).
- Right sides together, stitch the 10½-11½" rectangles to the top and bottom of the sailboat (c).
