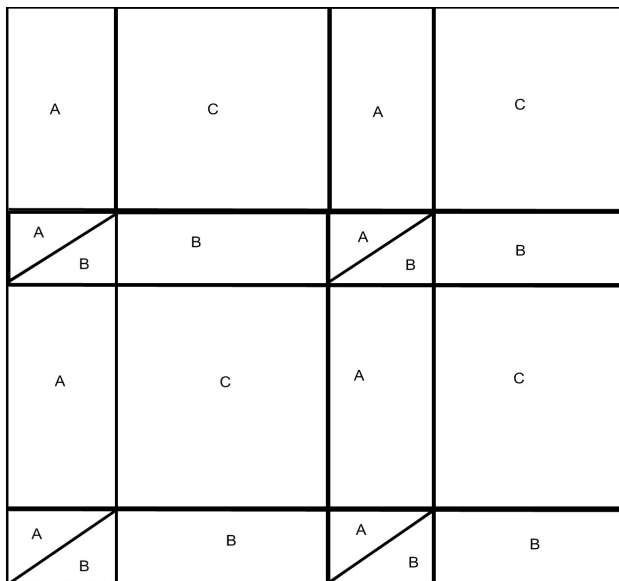


Rachel's Attic Windows

October 2009

Block is 12 1/2" When complete



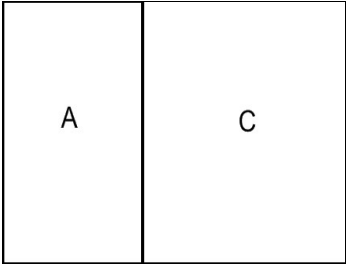
Fabric A pink
 4 = 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
 2 = 3" cut on diagonal

Fabric B purple
 4 = 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"
 2 = 3" cut on diagonal

Fabric C novelty print
 (either a "girly" print or floral)
 1 each of 4 different
 fabrics = 4 1/2" Square

Putting it together:

1. Sew pink rectangle A to C square into a row This will now be Row 1 (See the diagram to the right). You'll do this step 4 times.



2. Sew pink and purple (A and B) triangles together, add the purple rectangle B as shown to make row 2 (see the diagram to the right).



You'll do this step 4 times.

3. Add row 1 and row 2 together. Now you should have 4 small blocks. Sew the four blocks together to make a 12 1/2" square.
